MEETING IN SPECIAL SESSION ON JUNE 27, 2007**

THE GRAND JURORS of JACKSON County, Tennessee, duly empanelled and sworn upon their oath present that **JAMES DRAPER** on or before January 2006 in JACKSON County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully, intentionally or knowingly while being a public servant, to wit: a Deputy of the Jackson County Sheriff's Department, Gainesboro, Tennessee, with intent to obtain a benefit or to harm another, did commit an act relating to the servant's office or employment that constitutes an unauthorized exercise of official power, to wit: the said James Draper, did engage in oral sex with **Andrea Lawson**, an inmate of Jackson County Jail, said contact did occur in the Bonding Office at the Jackson County Jail, which is now the Jackson County Nurses Station, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated §39-16-402, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
